

Extra help

People with limited incomes may qualify for extra help to pay for their prescription drug costs. Medicare's Extra Help program helps cover the cost of prescription drug coverage. (You may also hear this referred to as an LIS, or low-income subsidy.) If you qualify, you could get help paying your monthly prescription drug premium, annual deductibles, and co-payments.

Do I qualify?

Learn whether you qualify for Extra Help by:

- Calling **Medicare** at **1-800-MEDICARE (TTY 877-486-2048)** 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
- Calling the **Social Security Administration** at **800-772-1213 (TTY 800-325-0778)** 8 a.m. through 7 p.m. Monday through Friday.
- Contacting your Medical Assistance (Medicaid) office.
- Visiting your local Social Security office to apply.
- Going online to apply for Extra Help at www.socialsecurity.gov/prescriptionhelp.
